



FLIGHT INFORMATION AND RULES

- Hot air balloons fly in Georgia all year round!
In summer season we fly from 5 to 9 in the morning, before thermals (vertical air flows) start to form; and from 6 to 7 in the evening after thermals are already gone.
In Autumn and spring, the morning flights commence a bit later, while the evening ones start earlier.
In Winter, we can fly all day (during daylight hours)
- Balloon flights are completely dependent on weather conditions: clouds, precipitation, visibility, wind. Weather forecast is usually available 24 hours before the flight, but it is still not 100% accurate. That's why even after you arrive to the launch site, your flight may be cancelled for safety reasons
- The flight itself usually takes around an hour, but the entire adventure (preparation, safety briefing, flight, descent, landing, and initiation ceremony) can take 2-3 hours
- For your safety, you must pay attention to and follow the pilot's instructions at all times
- Dress code: long pants (legs must be covered), long-sleeve shirt, comfortable closed shoes. Don't forget to cover your head to protect it from the heat of the burner. Heavy bags and large backpacks are not allowed on board
- Smoking, drinking of alcohol, and consumption of drugs and other psychoactive substances is prohibited during the flight
- Children are allowed to fly under the responsibility of parents or guardians
- In the unlikely event of flight cancellation due to bad weather, you will be given a full refund
